### **EBSCOhost**

Access to the *EBSCOhost* databases is supported in whole or part by the Institute of Museum and Library Services through the Library Services and Technology Act, administered by the New Jersey State Library, an affiliate of Thomas Edison State College and the four New Jersey Regional Library Cooperatives: Central Jersey, Highlands, INFOLINK and South Jersey.

#### ***CINAHL with Full Text***

*CINAHL with Full Text* is the world's most comprehensive source of full text for nursing & allied health journals, providing full text for more than 600 journals indexed in *CINAHL*. This authoritative file contains full text for many of the most used journals in the *CINAHL* index - with no embargo. Full-text coverage dates back to 1981.

#### ***Biomedical Reference Collection™: Comprehensive***

Designed for doctors, research scientists, students, clinical specialists and managers, this database provides nearly 900 full text journals, including nearly 850 peer-reviewed publications, covering virtually all areas of medical study. Journals available in full text in *Biomedical Reference Collection: Comprehensive Edition* are indexed in *MEDLINE*.

#### ***Nursing & Allied Health Collection™: Comprehensive***

Designed for nursing and allied health professionals, students, educators and researchers, this database provides full text for nearly 400 journals covering the areas of nursing, biomedicine, health sciences, consumer health and allied health disciplines. Nearly all full text titles included in *Nursing & Allied Health: Comprehensive Edition* are indexed in *CINAHL*.

#### ***Health Source: Nursing/Academic Edition***

This database provides nearly 550 scholarly full text journals focusing on many medical disciplines. *Health Source: Nursing/Academic Edition* also features the *Lexi-PAL Drug Guide*, which covers 1,300 generic drug patient education sheets with more than 4,700 brand names.

#### ***Health Source: Consumer Edition***

This database is the richest collection of consumer health information available to libraries worldwide, providing information on many health topics including the medical sciences, food sciences and nutrition, childcare, sports medicine and general health. *Health Source: Consumer Edition* provides access to nearly 80 full text, consumer health magazines.

#### ***Alt HealthWatch***

This database focuses on the many perspectives of complementary, holistic and integrated approaches to health care and wellness. It offers libraries full text articles for more than 180 international, and often peer-reviewed journals and reports. In addition, there are hundreds of pamphlets, booklets, special reports, original research and book excerpts. *Alt HealthWatch* provides in-depth coverage across the full spectrum of subject areas covered by complementary and alternative medicine. This database features indexing and abstracts going back as far as 1984, and full text going back as far as 1990

#### ***Health Business Fulltext Elite***

This database provides full text from more than 480 journals. *Health Business Elite* provides comprehensive journal content detailing all aspects of health care administration and other non-clinical aspects of health care institution management.

#### ***Business Source Elite***

This business database provides full text for nearly 1,100 business publications, including full text for nearly 500 peer-reviewed business publications. The rich collection of titles in *Business Source Elite* provides information dating back to 1985. This database is updated on a daily basis via *EBSCOhost*.

### **ERIC**

*ERIC*, the Educational Resource Information Center, contains more than 1,243,000 records and links to more than 224,000 full-text documents from *ERIC*.

### **Professional Development Collection**

Designed for professional educators, this database provides a highly specialized collection of nearly 520 high quality education journals, including nearly 350 peer-reviewed titles. This database also contains more than 200 educational reports. *Professional Development Collection* is the most comprehensive collection of full text education journals in the world.

### **Newspaper Source**

*Newspaper Source* provides cover-to-cover full text for 35 national & international newspapers. The database also contains selective full text for 375 regional (U.S.) newspapers. In addition, full text television & radio news transcripts are also provided.

### **Regional Business News**

This database provides comprehensive full text coverage for regional business publications. Regional Business News incorporates coverage of 75 business journals, newspapers and newswires from all metropolitan and rural areas within the United States. This database is updated on a daily basis.

### **MasterFILE Premier**

Designed specifically for public libraries, this multidisciplinary database provides full text for nearly 1,750 general reference publications with full text information dating as far back as 1975. Covering virtually every subject area of general interest, *MasterFILE Premier* also includes nearly 500 full text reference books, full text from 86,017 biographies, 105,786 full text primary source documents, and an Image Collection of 341,655 photos, maps and flags. This database is updated daily via *EBSCOhost*.

### **Science Reference Center**

This database is a comprehensive research database that provides easy access to a multitude of full text science-oriented content. This database contains full text for nearly 640 science encyclopedias, reference books, periodicals, etc. Topics covered include: biology, chemistry, earth & space science, environmental science, health & medicine, history of science, life science, physics, science & society, science as inquiry, scientists, technology and wildlife.

### **History Reference Center**

*History Reference Center* offers full text from more than 2,400 reference books, encyclopedias and non-fiction books, cover to cover full text for more than 130 leading history periodicals, more than 61,100 historical documents, 66,000 biographies of historical figures, more than 110,200 historical photos and maps, and more than 80 hours of historical video.

### **Literary Reference Center**

*Literary Reference Center* (LRC) is a comprehensive literary reference database, which provides users with a broad spectrum of reference information from antiquity to the present day. LRC is a comprehensive database that combines information from over 1,000 books and monographs, major literary encyclopedias and reference works, hundreds of literary journals, and unique sources not available anywhere else. LRC contains detailed information on the most studied authors and their works and is an essential resource for public, academic and high school libraries.

### **Biography Collection Complete**

*Biography Collection Complete* offers a comprehensive collection of full-text biographies supporting history, science, the arts, music, literature, multicultural studies, gender studies, business, government & politics, sports, entertainment and many other areas. This database features more than 177,000 full-text biographies from many different sources.

### **Funk & Wagnalls New World Encyclopedia**

This database provides over 25,000 encyclopedic entries covering a variety of subject areas.

### **TOPICsearch**

*TOPICsearch* contains full text for over 105,000 articles from 1,622 diverse sources including international and regional newspapers, EBSCO's unparalleled collection of periodicals, biographies, public opinion polls, book reviews, pamphlets, and government information.

### **Primary Search**

*Primary Search* provides full text for more than 70 popular, magazines for elementary school research. All full text articles included in the database are assigned a reading level indicator (Lexiles), and full text information dates as far back as 1990.

### **Middle Search Plus**

*Middle Search Plus* provides full text for more than 140 popular, middle school magazines. All full text articles included in the database are assigned a reading level indicator (Lexiles). Full text is also available for thousands of biographies and historical essays. *Middle Search Plus* also contains 84,774 biographies, 105,786 primary source documents, and an Image Collection of 341,655 photos, maps and flags.

### **MAS Ultra – School Edition**

Designed specifically for high school libraries, this database contains full text for more than 500 popular, high school magazines. *MAS Ultra – School Edition* also provides more than 360 full text reference books, 85,670 biographies, 105,786 primary source documents, and an Image Collection of 341,655 photos, maps & flags, color PDFs and expanded full text backfiles (back to 1975) for key magazines.

### **EBSCO Animals**

Provides in-depth information on a variety of topics relating to animals. The database consists of indexing, abstracts, and full text records describing the nature and habitat of familiar animals.

### **GreenFILE**

*GreenFILE* offers well-researched information covering all aspects of human impact to the environment. Its collection of scholarly, government and general-interest titles includes content on global warming, green building, pollution, sustainable agriculture, renewable energy, recycling, and more. The database provides indexing and abstracts for more than 384,000 records, as well as Open Access full text for more than 4,700 records.

### **Library, Information Science & Technology Abstracts**

*Library, Information Science & Technology Abstracts* (LISTA) indexes more than 500 core journals, more than 50 priority journals, and 125 selective journals; plus books, research reports and proceedings. Subject coverage includes librarianship, classification, cataloging, bibliometrics, online information retrieval, information management and more. Coverage in the database extends back as far as the mid-1960s.

### ***Evidence Based Medicine Reviews***

Helps clinicians practice Evidence Based Medicine through a combination of resources that provide systematic reviews of topics; article reviews; and access to definitive controlled trials. Consists of *ACP Journal Club*, *Cochrane Central Register of Controlled Trials*, *Cochrane Database of Systematic Reviews*, *Database of Abstracts of Reviews of Effects*, *Cochrane Methodology Register*, *Health Technology Assessment*, and the *NHS Economic Evaluation Database*. Coverage for all of these resources is current for the previous three month Quarter, except for *ACP Journal Club* which begins in 1991. *The Cochrane Central Register of Controlled Trials*' coverage extends back two years.

### **\*PubMed**

*PubMed* is a free service of the U.S. National Library of Medicine that includes over 18 million citations from *MEDLINE* and other life science journals for biomedical articles back to the 1950s.

*PubMed* has an easy to use basic search feature which is also available in *Ovid*'s *MEDLINE*, but it can return large numbers of irrelevant articles. The advanced search capabilities available in both *PubMed* and *Ovid* can be more difficult to learn, but allow a greater level of control over a search which can result in retrieval of fewer irrelevant articles. The advanced search technique is easier to learn in *OVID* and offers some important features which *PubMed* does not.

The customized *PubMed* link on our database page provides links to both Saint Peter's and Drexel University's full text articles and information regarding our print holdings.

### **\*UpToDate**

*UpToDate*, a full-text clinical reference, covers more than [7,400 topics](#) in 13 medical specialties and includes more than 76,000 pages of text, graphics, links to Medline abstracts, more than 254,000 references, and a drug database. Our physician editors and authors review and update the content continuously. An updated version of *UpToDate* is released every four months.
